Priorities Diseases



- Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD)
- Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE)
- Screw Worm
- Highly Pathogen Avian Influenza (HPAI)
- Classical Swine Fever (CSF)
- Rabies

Reccomendations for the GF-TADs SC



- Continue acting in the coordination of sanitary priorities and regional programs, based on the Public and Private Global and Regional International Organizations interaction within this framework
- Contribution on the "One Health" concept, taking into consideration the tripartite document issued by the FAO/OIE/WHO

Reccomendations for the Veterinary Services



- Use of the OIE's PVS pathway
- Participation in the Laboratories Network of the Veterinary Services of the Americas.
- Development of studies on cost/benefit and other social economic aspects of animal health

Reccomendations Foot and Mouth Disease



- Need to support the Action Plan 2011-2020 of the Hemispheric Plan for the Eradication of Foot and Mouth Disease-PHEFA
- Outlining a master plan and roadmap for the prevention, progressive control and eradication of FMD
- Coordination between OIE Reference Laboratories

Reccomendations Screw Worm



- To speed up the submission of comments from the countries on the FAO's Roadmap for the eradication of the Screw Worm in the endemic areas of the American Continent
- Submission of a joint request by COMEXA and COPEG to become an OIE Collaborating Centre.

Reccomendations Classical Swine Fever



 Need of a strategy to improve the progressive control of the classical swine fever in the countries of the Caribbean.



The interaction and coordination among global, regional and sub regional organizations, private organizations and Veterinary Authorities is of paramount importance to achieve the goals of the GF–TADs in the Americas
