


Biennial evaluation plan of the Forestry and timber subprogramme for 2014-2015

Note by the Secretariat

Introduction

At the UNECE Commission session in 2004, member States agreed to place more emphasis on evaluation as a tool to review the implementation of the programme of the Commission. All sectoral Committees were therefore requested by the Commission to conduct biennial evaluations of their respective subprogrammes and to take into account the results of these evaluations in determining their work programmes. The 2005 UNECE reform further strengthened this approach.

The biennial evaluations should give an opportunity for the members of each Sectoral Committee to review and reaffirm, on a continuous basis, the relevance of the activities and their clusters in view of the subprogrammes' objectives. The results of these evaluations should contribute to defining subprogramme priorities and the related redistribution of resources.
