## **CAPE VERDE – Agricultural Census 2004 – Explanatory Notes**

#### **Historical outline:**

The first Census of Agriculture in Cape Verde was undertaken in 1963. The second and third agricultural censuses were carried out in 1978 and 1988 respectively. The 2004 General Census of Agriculture (RGA) to which data presented here refer, is the fourth ever conducted in the country.

## **Organization:**

Under a resolution of Council of Ministers the organization of the RGA at central level was entrusted to the Ministry of Environment, Agriculture and Fisheries (MAAP) which carried out the census through various field offices under its control. The National Statistics Institute (INE) was responsible for technical co-ordination. The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) provided technical assistance during the preparatory phase of the Census. The Government of Sweden, through the Swedish Bureau of Statistics, helped in the execution of census operations. After the Census, the Government of Italy, through the National Statistical Office (ISTAT), provided assistance for developing a permanent Statistical System in the country.

# **Enumeration period:**

Data were collected during the period 3 May to 31 July 2004.

## Reference period:

For the majority of census items the reference period was the agricultural year 2003/2004, i.e. from 1<sup>st</sup> May 2003 to 30 April 2004.

For census items like number of livestock, holding characteristics and farm population the reference time was the day of the enumerator's visit.

#### **Definitions:**

<u>Agricultural holding</u> was the statistical unit of the census. The holding was defined as all land and livestock kept under single management, without regard to title or size. The holdings were classified as those belonging to the household sector or to the non-household sector. Non-household holdings were the units involved in crops and livestock production, managed by cooperatives, collectives, government or private corporations.

<u>Agricultural Holder</u> was defined as the person who has the moral and financial responsibility of carrying out the agricultural operations and takes the major decisions regarding use of resources.

## Coverage:

The General Census of Agriculture 2004 was designed to cover both rural and urban areas in all islands of Cape Verde.

#### **Methods:**

Complete enumeration of all holdings was carried out. Data were collected by enumerators through direct interview.

### Frame:

In order to build the census frame, maps of census cartography were provided by the National Statistics Institute (INE). A list of households prepared for the Population and Housing General Census conducted in 2000 was also used to prepare the frame for RGA.
