Political will

- Establishment of National Food and Nutrition Council
- National development plan
- Implementation of Malnutrition Zero Programme
- Cash transfer interventions (mother, children, school children and senior citizens)
- Land reform
- Other interventions

External factors:

 Rise of highly demanded products (wheat, sugar and oil)

Climate change (floods, dryness)

Economic and financial crisis

Policy making processes

- > Response to acute problems by the executive
- Implementation of the article 16th of the New Constitution and other related issues
 - Law 144 "Communitarian agriculture productive revolution" demanded by social organizations
 - Regulation of the law
- Decentralization of the laws via local norms, regulations and policies

Budget for implementation of programmes


Programmes that have total or partial budget:

 Cash transferences, micro irrigation for rural municipalities. Malnutrition Zero programme, Literacy and post literacy


 Programmes derived from the Law 144 not yet contemplated in the national budget

Coordination and coherence

In process:



- Regulated by DS 28667 de abril 2006
- Composed by ministeries and social organizations
- Presided by the Presidente
- Technical Secretariat : MOH
- Technical Commite to facilitate processes
- Local leve: Departmental and municipal councils



Main coordination constraints

- Diverse understanding of right to food issues by different sectors
- Social organizations are more interested in food production
- Insufficient coordination at municipal and local levels in the implementation of programmes

Main coordination achievements

- Developed a national programme to reduce infant malnutrition
- Inclusion of right to food concepts in the new norms and laws
- Visibilization of social aspects of food security
