



High Level Panel of Experts on Food Security and Nutrition

Call for candidatures to the HLPE Project Teams

The High Level Panel of Experts (HLPE) on food security and nutrition has been created as part of the reform of the international governance of food security to advise the Committee on World Food Security (CFS) which is the foremost intergovernmental and international platform dealing with food security and nutrition.

The HLPE is now calling for motivated high level experts to form separate 2 Project Teams to write, according to the HLPE Rules and procedures, draft reports on

Social protection and food security

And on

Climate change and food security

The two Project Teams will work from October 2011 until June 2012, under the Oversight of the Steering Committee of the HLPE.

The reports of the HLPE, requested by the Committee on World Food Security (CFS), will be sent to the CFS end June 2012, and presented at CFS Plenary by October 2012.

As in other expert panels (IPCC, IAASTD), reimbursement of previously agreed support expenses, such as internal meetings of the HLPE, will be provided.
