



GLOBAL AND LOCAL FOOD GOVERNANCE SEMINARS

Within the context of "EXPO 2015", the Institut Français d'Italie; the Master in Human Development and Food Security, Roma Tre University; CIRAD; Montpellier SupAgro; the Unesco Chair "Alimentations du Monde" (Montpellier); the International Urban Food Network (IUFN) and the Centre international de hautes études agronomiques méditerranéennes-Institut agronomique méditerranéen de Montpellier (CIHEAM-IAMM) are jointly organizing a cycle of five round tables on Global and Local Food Governance.
