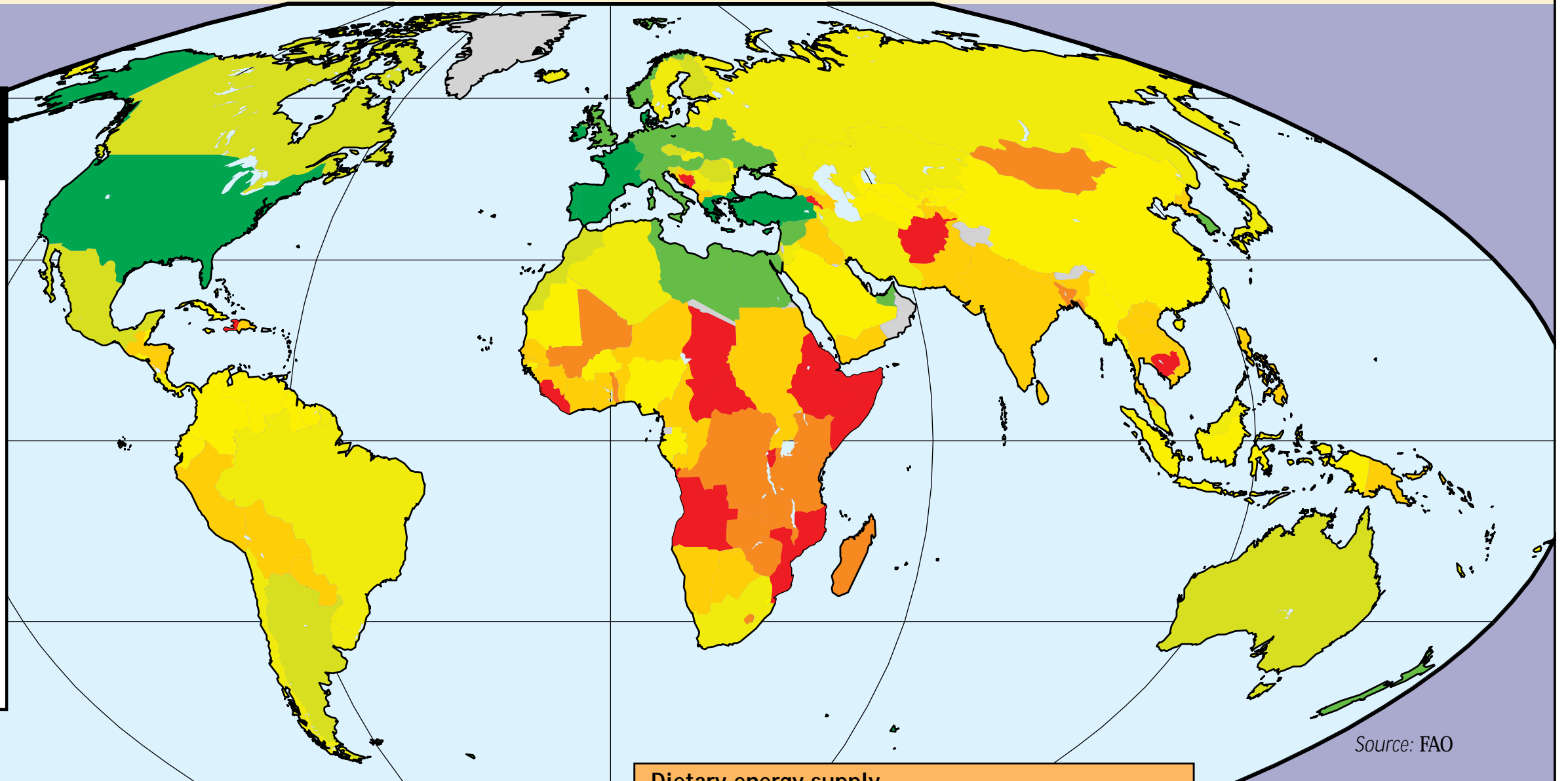
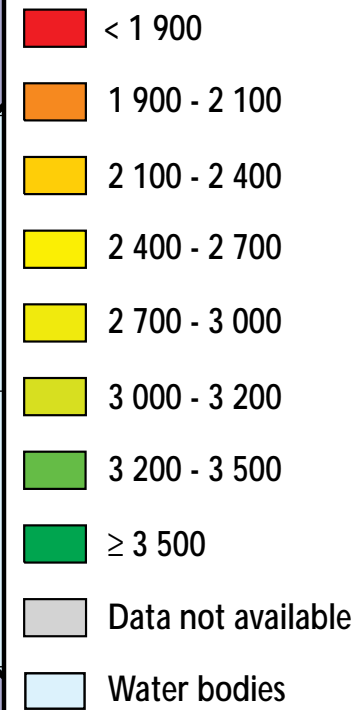

While levels of DES (average energy supply per caput per day, measured in Calories) have increased substantially as a world average since 1970, in many countries they remain very low.
