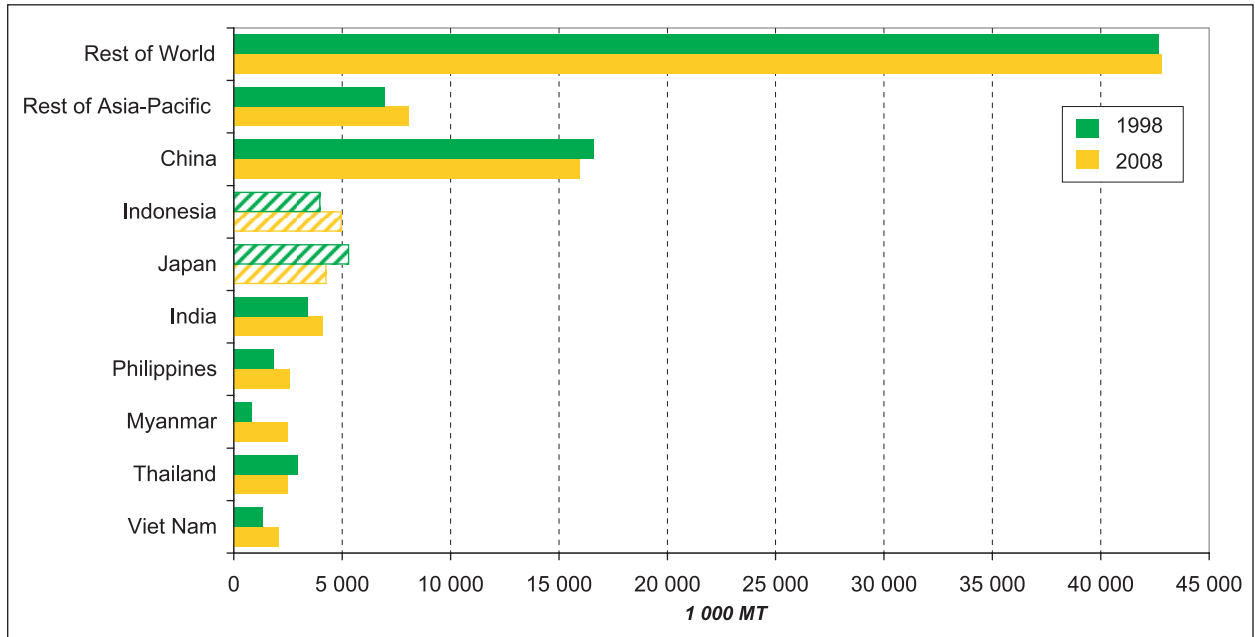


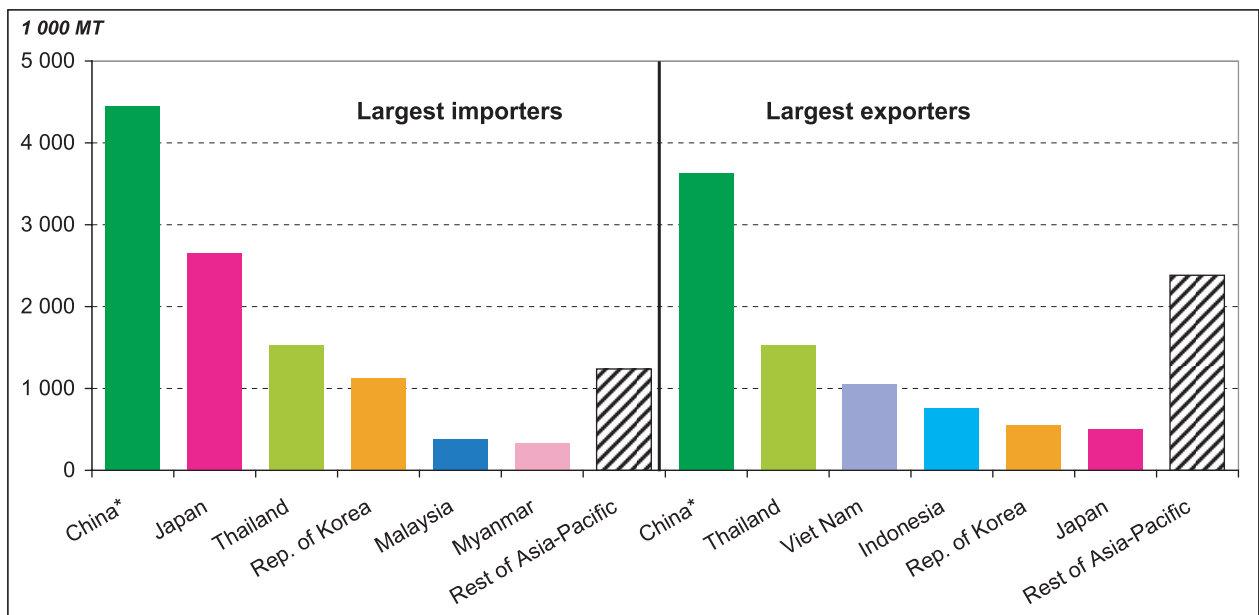

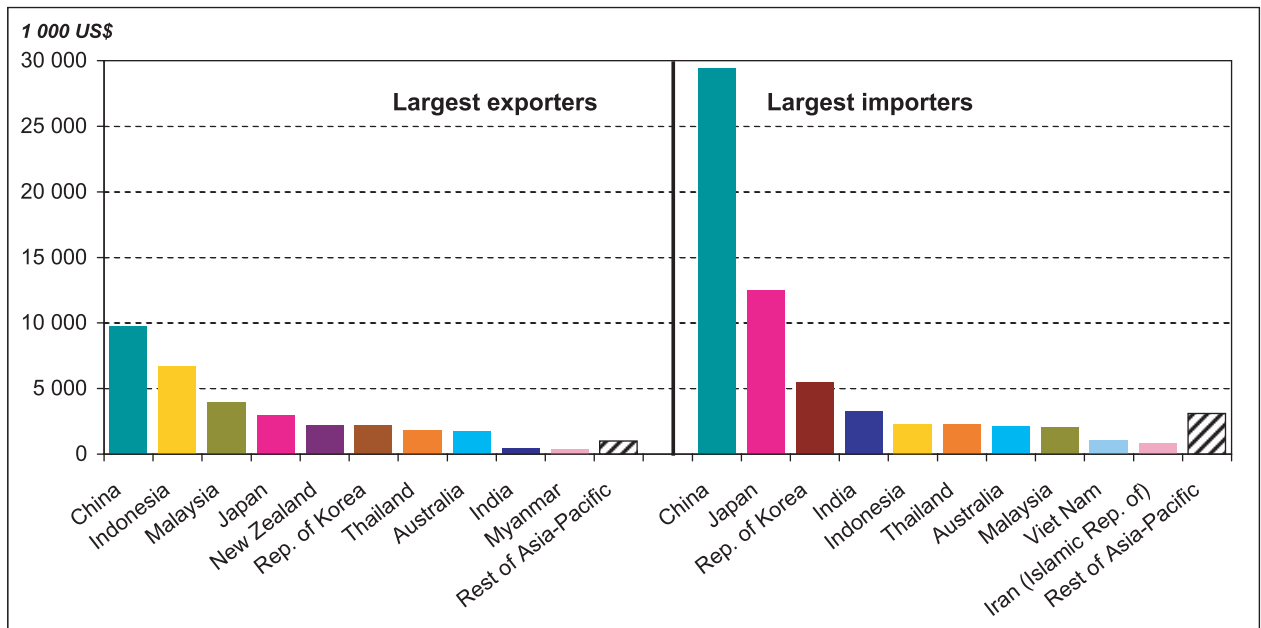
Roundwood: production

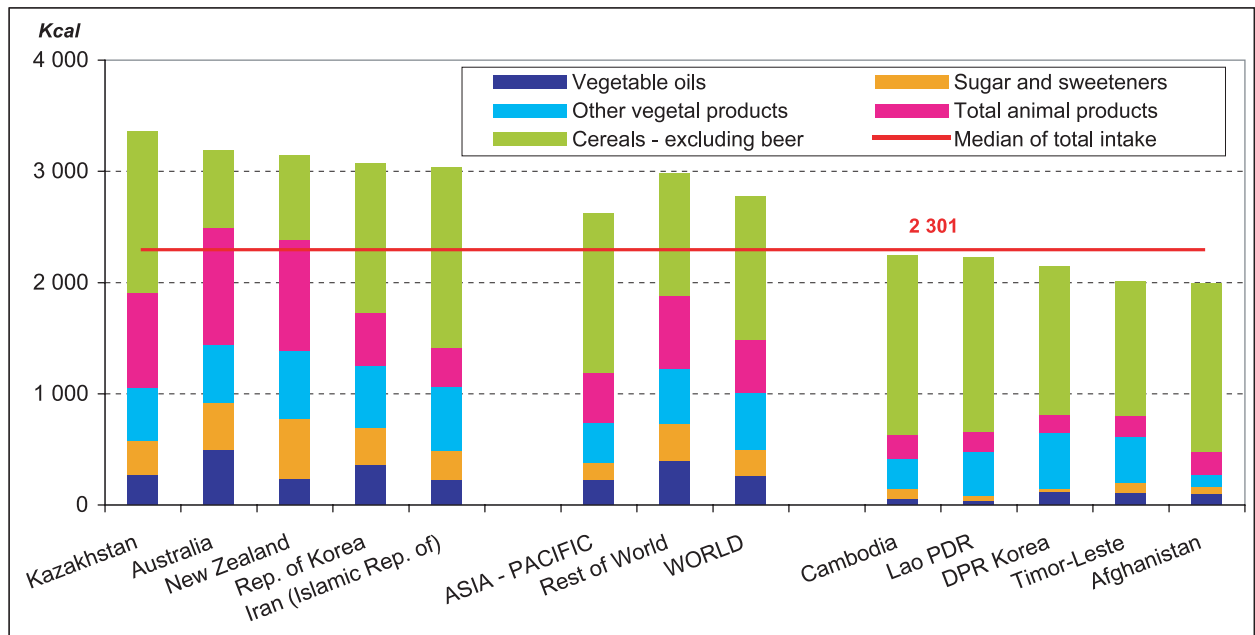

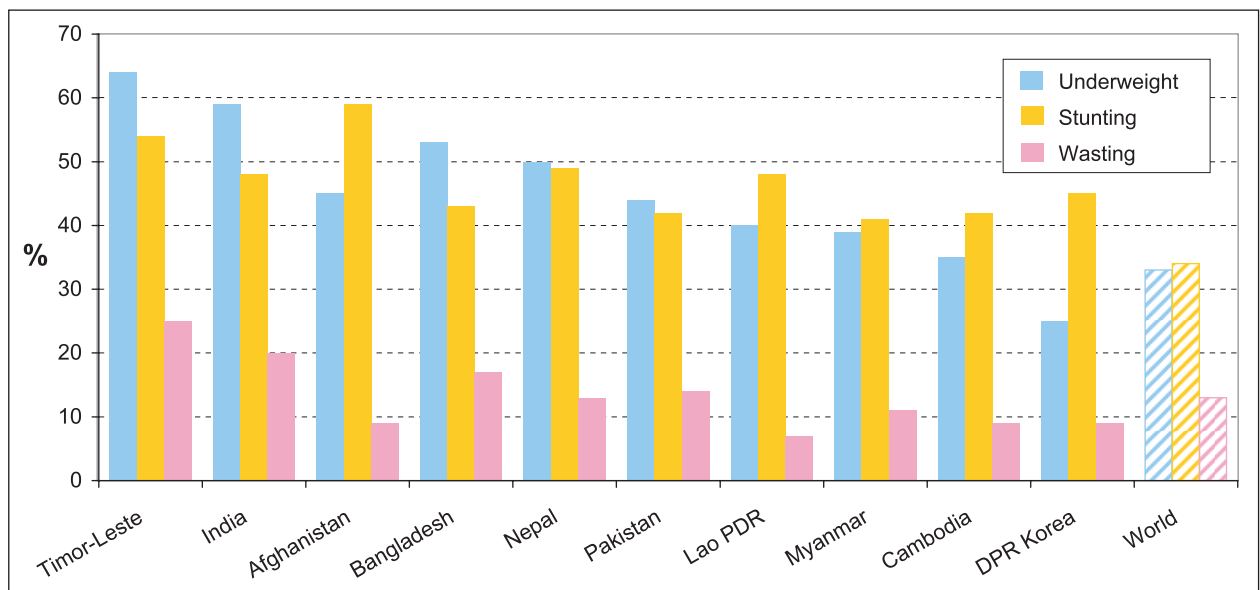
Energy daily intake

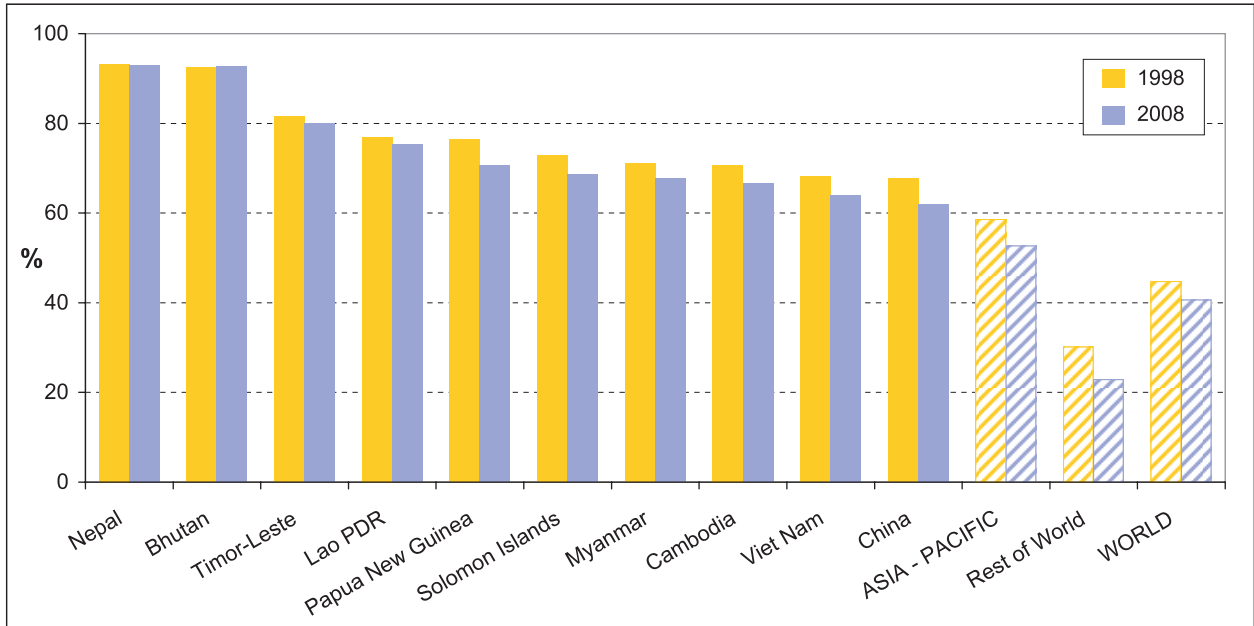

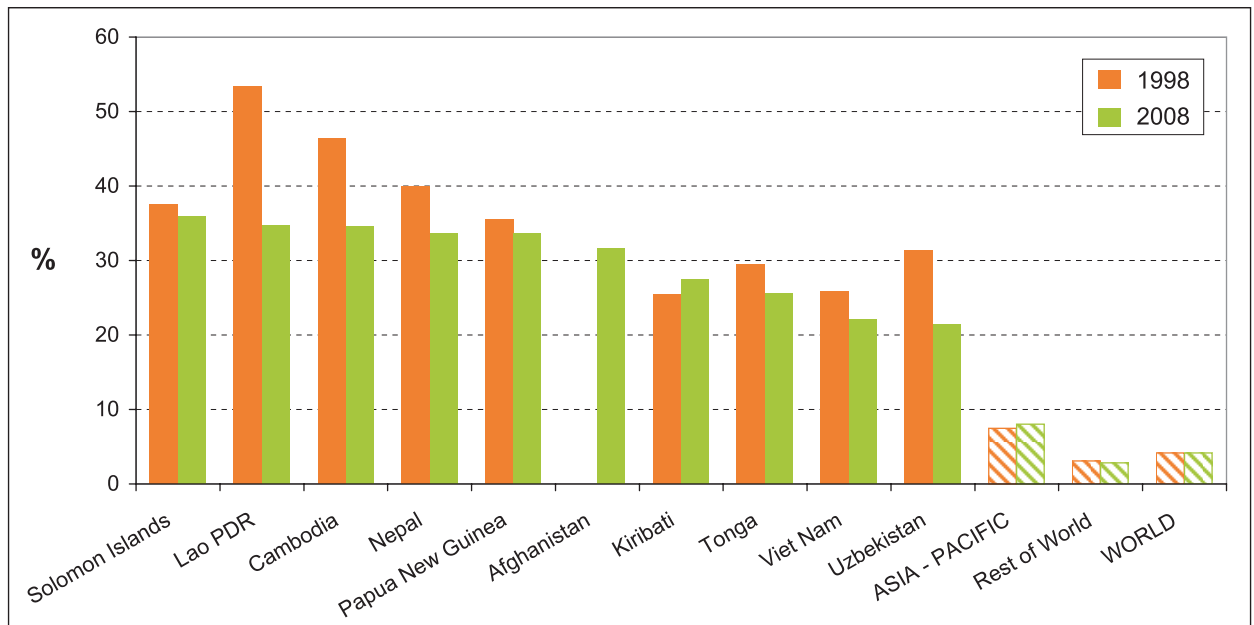
Labour force in agriculture
