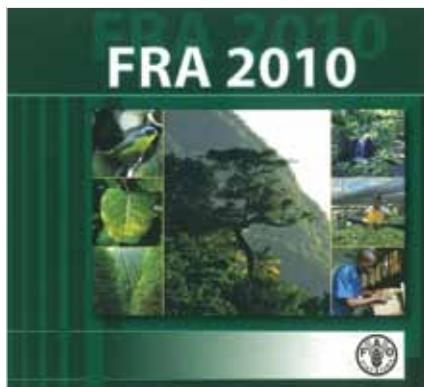




## FAO's Global Forest Resources Assessment

**FAO'S GLOBAL FOREST RESOURCES ASSESSMENT (FRA)** is an ongoing process to generate the best possible data on the world's forests. The most recent published report, FRA 2010, covers 233 countries for the period 1990–2010, and presents country-level data on more than 90 key variables related to the extent, condition, uses and values of forests.
