



FAO's Global Forest Resources Assessment

FAO'S GLOBAL FOREST RESOURCES ASSESSMENT (FRA) is an ongoing process to generate the best possible data on the world's forests. The most recent published report, FRA 2010, covers 233 countries for the period 1990–2010, and presents country-level data on more than 90 key variables related to the extent, condition, uses and values of forests.
