


Figure 12.2 Road Barriers to Trade in West Africa, April-June, 2010

truckers information about their legal rights and obligations under regional trade accords. 164 Togo's success reducing the number of such barriers indicates that governments can do something about this problem. The persistence of such barriers in several countries suggests that some governments are reluctant to address the problem aggressively, perhaps because such illegal payments represent an off-budget subsidy to the security forces. The
