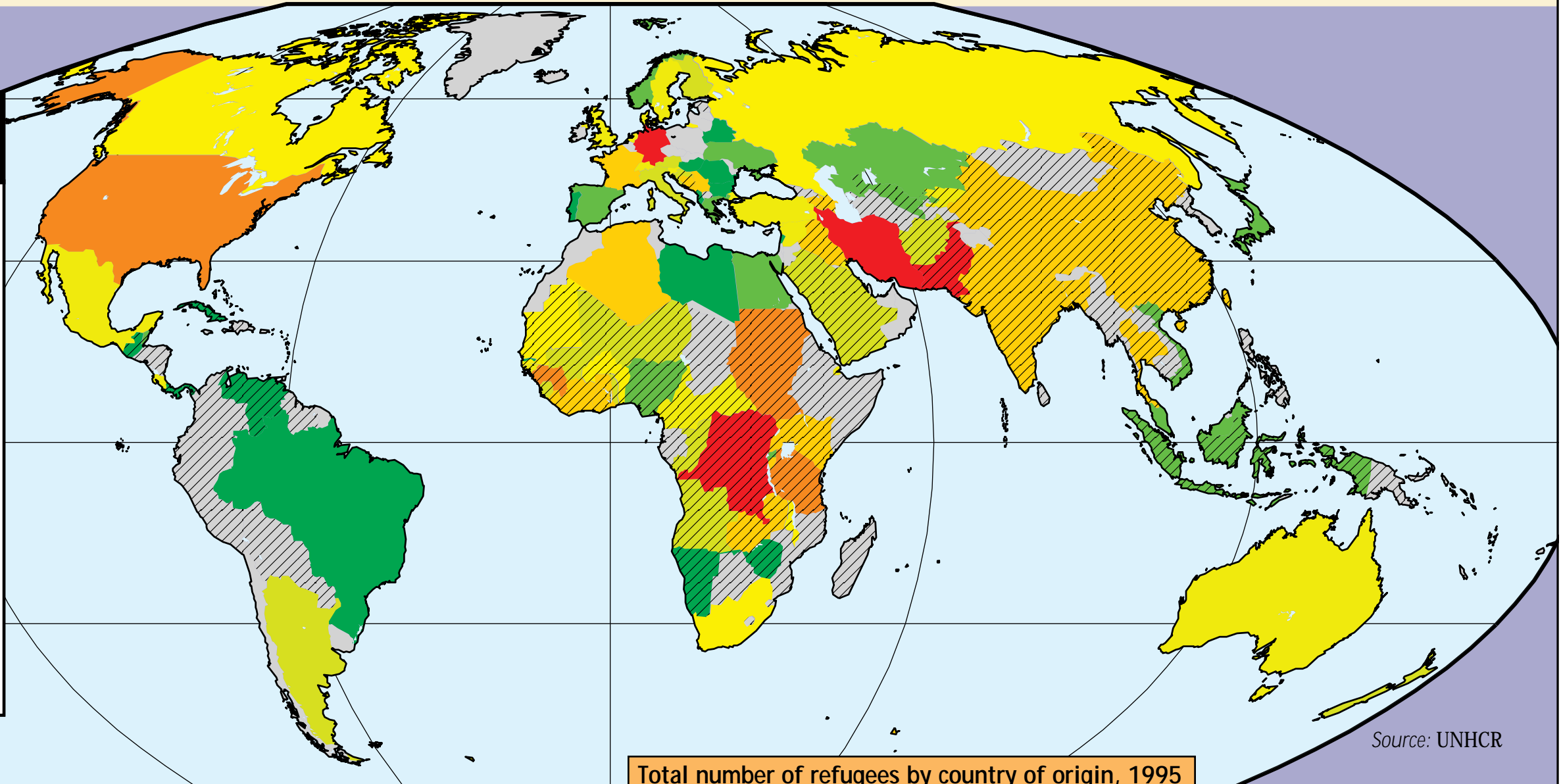
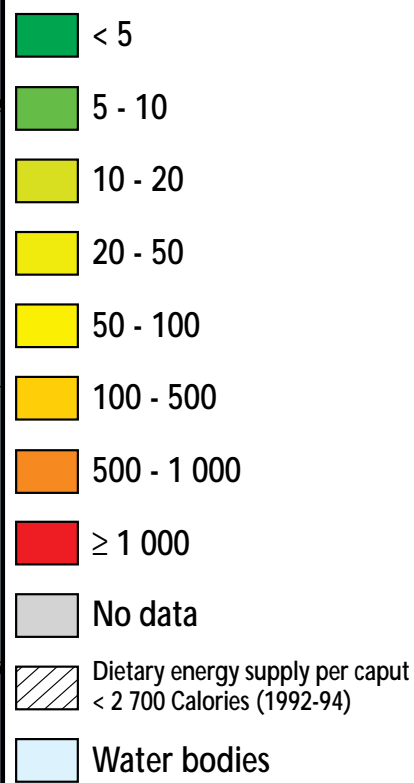

Refugees by destination, 1995 (thousands)

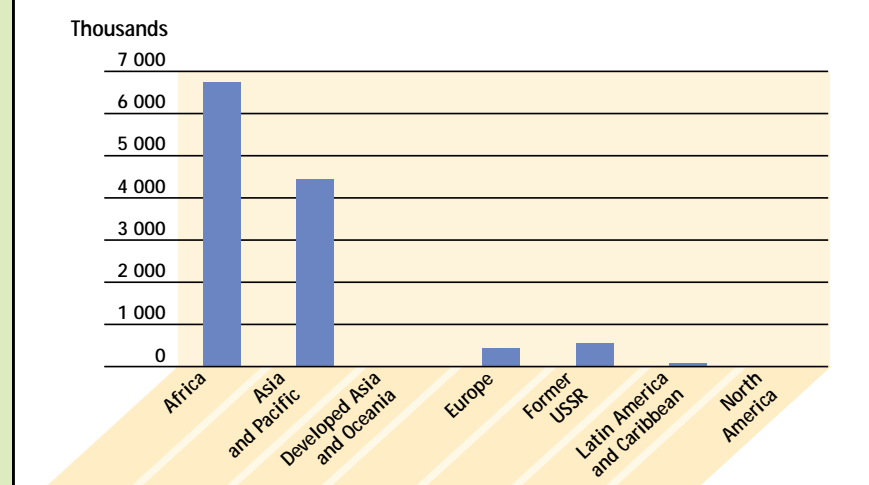
