i. Five Years of Action for the Development of Mountain Regions

At its 174th Session, the FAO Council noted the Global Framework for the Five Years of Action for the Development of Mountain Regions 2023–2027⁷ as declared by the United Nations General Assembly in December 2022 (A/RES/77/172).⁸ The Council also called for the development of the Global Action Plan on Mountain Regions Development 2023–2027. In response, the Mountain Partnership Secretariat at FAO prepared the Global Action Plan on Mountain Regions Development 2023–2027, in collaboration with other United Nations and regional organizations.⁹

ii. Voluntary Code of Conduct for the sustainable use and management of plastics in agriculture

In response to the recommendations of the 28th Session of the Committee on Agriculture, subsequently endorsed by the 43rd Session of the FAO Conference, FAO has carried out consultations with Members and stakeholders towards the development of the Voluntary Code of Conduct for the sustainable use and
