#### Field trip

11. On Thursday, 8 March there will be a field visit. It is recommended that participants wear light and comfortable clothes, appropriate for the season.

#### General information about the country

- 12. **Paraguay** (in guarani: Paraguái), officially the Republic of Paraguay, is located at the South-East of South America. The Paraguayan territory occupies two different regions separated by the Paraguay River: the Oriental one, which is the most populated, and the Western one, which is part of the Northern Chaco. The official languages are Spanish and Guarani. Paraguay is a Unitary State with a tripartite division of the powers of the State (Judicial, Legislative and Executive). The country is divided into 17 Departments. It does not possess ocean coasts, although it's fluvial coasts irrigate two important rivers, the Paraguay and the Parana, that flow naturally into the *Rio de la Plata*, both totally navigable.
- 13. The Very Noble and Loyal City of our Lady Santa Maria of the **Asuncion** (complete official name of the city) is the capital and the most populated city of the Republic of Paraguay. It is an autonomous municipality and independent City District; this means that it is not formally integrated to any department. It is located along the Bay of Asuncion, on the left shoreline of the Paraguay River opposite to the confluence with the Pilcomayo river. The city is divided into six districts and 23 quarters. It is the location of the three powers of the State. The metropolitan area, called Big Asuncion, includes the municipalities of San Lorenzo, Lambare, Fernando de la Mora, Capiata, Luque, Mariano Roque Alonso, Ñemby, Villa Elisa and San Antonio. It is known by the name of "Mother of Cities". It's area is 117 square kilometers in the city, and 1000 square kilometers in Gran Asuncion.

#### **Climate**

14. Climate of Asunción is subtropical, summers are warm and in the winter low temperatures can ocurr. Rains and electrical thunderstorms are frequent during great part of the year; due to this the relative average moisture is 71%. Due mainly to it's geographical position, Asuncion is one the warmest cities of Latin America, registering high temperatures almost the whole year. For the month of March the average daily temperature fluctuates between a minimum of 20°C and a maximum of 30°C.
