THERE IS WATER NEARBY!

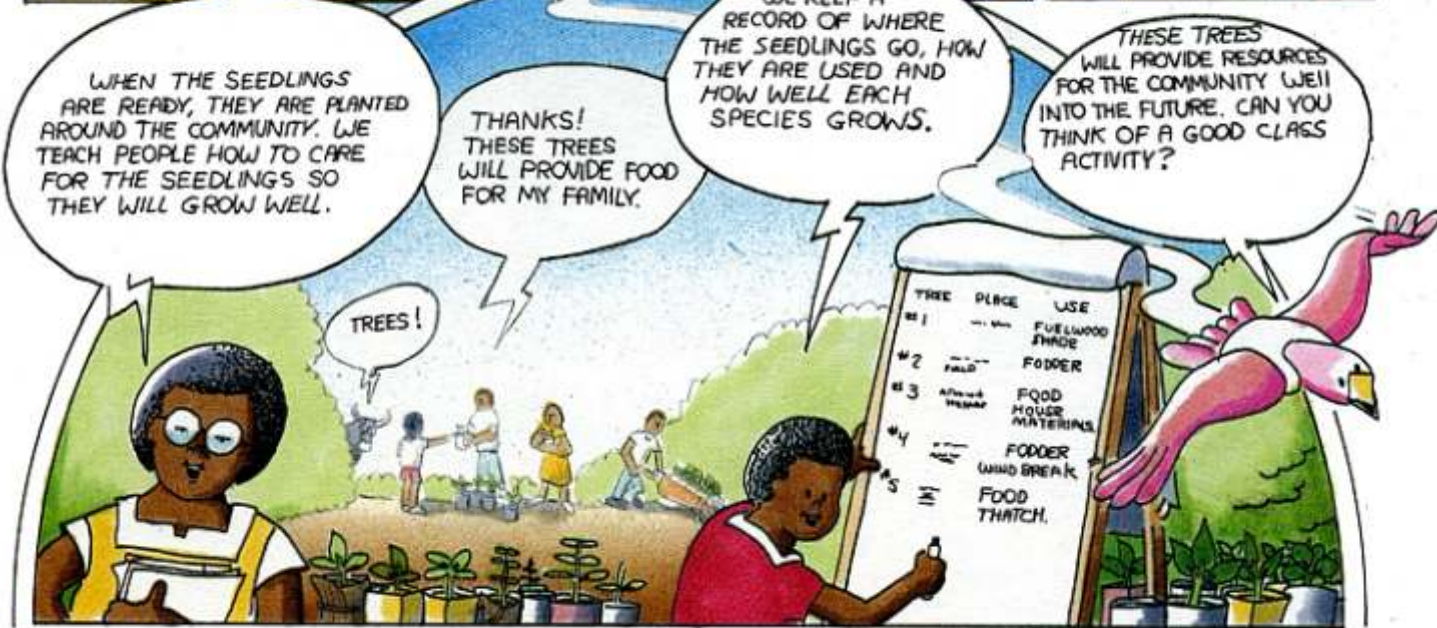
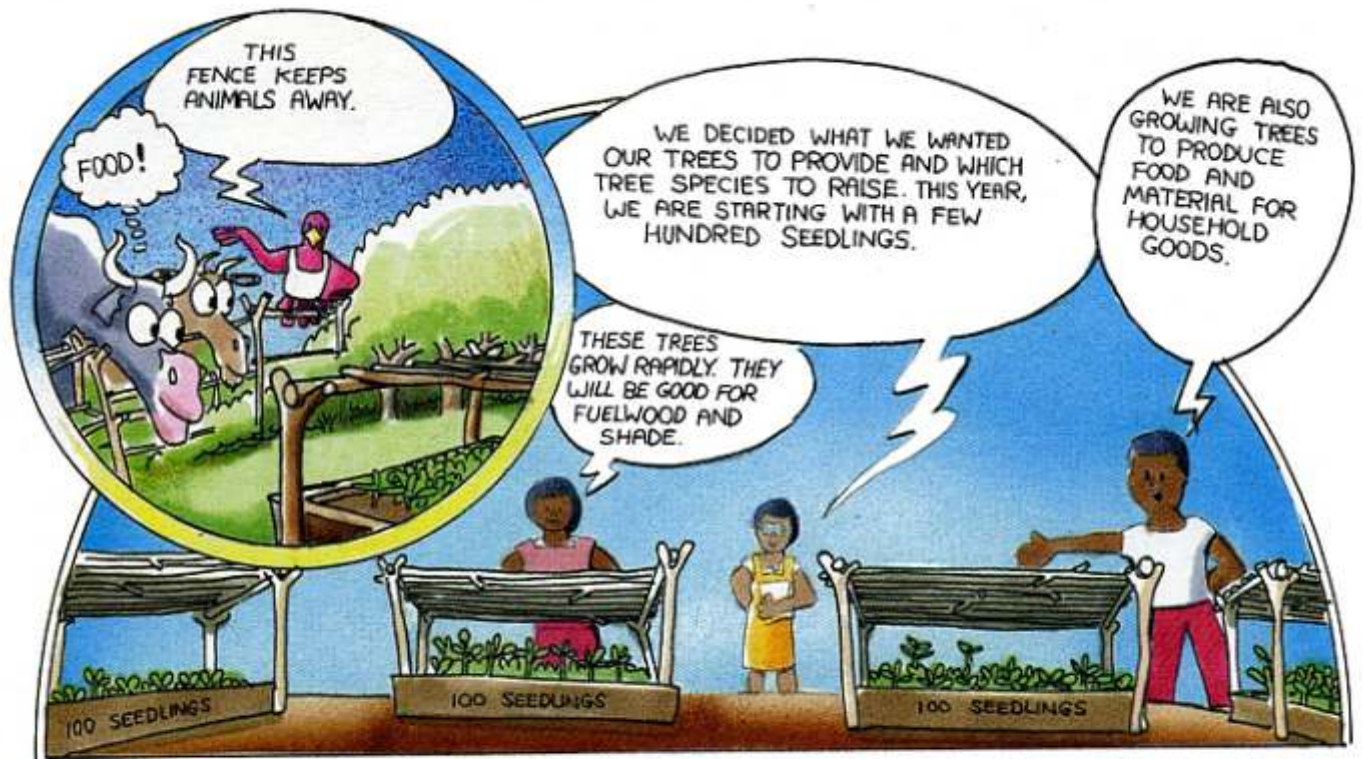
THE GROUND IS GOOD AND FLAT.
