APPENDIX B: Approach & methodology

The approach to the analysis divided into the following activities:

1. Inception

- Overview on the current status of fisheries;
- Review of actions and trends in Post-Tsunami longer-term development assistance in the fisheries sector;
- Review of national policy initiatives and frameworks for fisheries resource development and management and their outcomes;
- Review of donor support initiatives and their outcomes;
- Identification of both institutional and private key stakeholders; and
- Review of legal support structures.

2. Institutional Review

- A review of fisheries in the context of the external environment;
- Institutional capacity;
- Institutional performance and SWOT;
- Institutional motivation; and
- Review of institutional relevance.

3. Identification of policy priorities and review of strategies for implementation including:

- Fisheries management;
- Coastal zone management;
- Promoting production, sustaining or improving employment and improving coastal livelihoods;
- Food safety and market promotion.

4. Legal Review

- Consequences of the new legislation on the current regulatory frameworks for fisheries;
- Weaknesses of current policy and strategies; and
- Implementation strategies and the consequences of the proposed legislation.

5. Training needs assessment

- Identification of key human resource development needs;
- Identification of training and capacity building requirements and support structures; and
- Identification of staff development opportunities.

6. Development and institutional programming

- Identification of development needs for key stakeholders on community level;
- Translating policy into action;
- Refining public sector governance roles in the context of service delivery structures;
- Development of private-public partnerships; and
- Implementation plan: Log Frame, key milestones and budgetary support.
