This screen allows you to manage the list of SMTAs: by clicking the appropriate button, located above the list, you can choose to view only the SMTA incoming, outgoing or all of SMTAs managed locally by Gene-IT. On the right of each line, a green or orange icon indicates the direction of the SMTA exchange.

Double-clicking on a line opens the window and displays the SMTA.



### A-2.3) MANAGEMENT OF ACCESSIONS (MCPD)

The management of accessions is conducted by Gene-IT in nomenclature MCPD (Multi-Crop Passport Data). The button "MTA List" at the bottom left, displays the list of SMTA including the accession currently on the screen. As in the view "Contacts", by making double-click on a line of the list and Gene-IT will show the details of the SMTA.

## B) Toolbar « Info »



The toolbar "Info" contains four buttons to access the text of the Treaty and that of the SMTA, and some additional background information on the International Treaty and its implementation.

### (1) B-1) TEXT OF THE INTERNATIONAL TREATY

Clicking on this button allows you to view, in one of the six official languages of FAO and by language being used by Gene-IT, the full text of the International Treaty in PDF format. A programme for reading this format (Acrobat, Foxit, etc.) is required on your computer to take advantage of this feature.

### B-2) TEXT OF THE SMTA

This button allows you to view, in one of six languages of FAO and by language being used by Gene-IT, the full text of the Standard Material Transfer Agreement. As the previous button, you will need a programme to read PDF (Acrobat, Foxit, etc.) installed on your computer.

### B-3) LIST OF CROPS LISTED IN THE ANNEX I OF THE INTERNATIONAL TREATY

Clicking the "Annex I" button displays a window with the species listed in the Annex I of the International Treaty.



Click on genre to see any comments on it. Use the side bar on the right side of the list to scroll it.

In order to obtain a hard copy or PDF format, click on "Print" ————. Then, you will preview the file.



One click on the button will let you to choose the printer and the number of copies.

Click on to create a PDF file from the preview, which could be use, for example, with Acrobat Reader<sup>®</sup>.

Once the consultation is completed, click on the OK button to close the window and to return to the screen on the legal characteristics of the genetic resources transferred.

## B-4) WEB SITE OF THE INTERNATIONAL TREATY

If you have an active Internet connection, this button lets you to start Internet Explorer and to visit the homepage of the International Treaty in English, French or Spanish (<a href="http://www.planttreaty.org/">http://www.planttreaty.org/</a>)

### b) C) Toolbar « tools »



This toolbar allows you to access features available in Gene-IT, but also to quit the software.


# C-1) STANDARD LETTER TO NOTIFY THE INCLUSION OF GENETIC MATERIAL IN THE MLS

This button allows you to get into your word processor, using the RTF format, to write a letter to notify the inclusion of genetic material in the Multilateral System. This document can be adapted to your own needs.

## C-2) IMPORT OF ACCESSION RELATED INFORMATION


With this button is possible to import the characteristics of the accessions, according to the format MCPD . The export of such data from third-party software is not part of this project.

## C-3) IMPORT OF SMTA RELATED INFORMATION



If your counterpart also uses Gene-IT, you can import all the information related to the SMTA with this button. For that, you need to get through your choice of the swap file, exported from your ISP's genetic materials (see A.1-6 Export the SMTA). Once the file is loaded, clicking on the button "Import" to include all the information related to the SMTA in your local database.

### C-4) ANALYSES OF EXCHANGES




This button allows you to create several tables to give you an overview of your exchange activities under the International Treaty.

By clicking on the appropriate buttons, you select the type of information (organizations, country, SMTA) which should be in the row of the table, while the columns will be filled with information on varieties or genre taxonomy.

Clicking on the "Print" will let you to preview, print and export in various formats, this general overview table.

## C-5) CONFIGURATION OF GENE-IT

The button "Configuration" allows the setup of the Gene-IT software environment, particularly the customization of the interface language. You can select to use one of the six official languages of FAO.




It is also through this screen that the choice of the identity of the supplier is archived.

There are other tools to physically maintain (re-indexing, repair, etc) to the local database and to manage the image library used to illustrate some screens of Gene-IT.

Note 1: Changing the language of the interface will restart the software to implement the changes.

Note 2: The choice of the language will only affect the software interface, not the data exchanged, which will be available only in English.

# C-6) EXIT GENE-IT



This button lets you close the program and end your session.

A new use will require you to log in again to enjoy access rights associated with your account (see 3.1).
