



## SAVING OUR PLANET'S SECOND-LARGEST LUNG: HOW THE CONGO BASIN FOREST CONTRIBUTES TO PROTECTING GLOBAL CLIMATE AND THREATENED BIODIVERSITY

The tropical forest ecosystems of the Congo Basin are essential for fighting climate change and maintaining biodiversity. To attract much needed attention and funding to these crucial ecosystems, the members of the Congo Basin Forest Partnership (CBFP) adopted in September 2021 a joint Declaration that calls for a "Fair Deal", combining the protection, sustainable use, and good governance of the Congo Basin Forest ecosystems by riparian countries in exchange for an adequate share of international climate and biodiversity funds. Putting this declaration into action is crucial to its success. What has progress been so far?
