Decent work is fundamental to ensuring sustainable and productive forestry operations that are efficient, environmentally friendly, and safer for those working in them

The forest sector provides employment to some 33 million people globally, accounting for 1 per cent of total employment in all economic activities. Furthermore, forests provide livelihoods, food, shelter, ecosystem services and many other benefits for millions of people around the world. This session will highlight approaches, opportunities and challenges of sectoral stakeholders, including employers' and workers' organizations, in promoting green jobs and decent work as a cornerstone for a viable contribution of the forest sector to growth and sustainability.
