TNAC 2025 - Background

- 3 Agricultural censuses already undertaken in 1985, 2001 and 2015
- 2025 is the 4th Agriculture census for Tonga
- 1st time to use CAPI for Agriculture census
- Very rich questionnaire in terms of modules and questions compared to previous census

TNAC 2025 – Challenges

- Funding
- Collaborations amongst key players
- Lack of institutional knowledge in this area
- Recruitment of large field staff
- Tight surveys and census calendar
- Long questionnaires counterproductive

TNAC 2025 – Way Forward

- Decide the best time to Conduct TNAC given the other national surveys taken
- Include questions in the PHC to identify households involved in 'ownaccount' as frame for TNAC
- Initial step is to secure enough funding
- Explore other modalities in conducting Census that is cost effective given that funding is currently the main obstacle
- Have a designated staff or staffs for Agriculture Census

TNAC 2025 – Recommendations

- Module to collect data regarding Climate Change
