REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

3. Codex Members and Observers are invited to submit comments on the draft Regional Standard for Fermented Noni Fruit Juice, which is uploaded to the Codex Online Commenting System (OCS): <https://ocs.codexalimentarius.org/>, as per the guidance below.
4. Comments should address whether the text is ready for adoption or not; and if not, provide the rationale and proposals to facilitate adoption. Comments should be provided in conformity with the *Procedure for the Elaboration of Codex Standards and Related Texts* (Part 3 – *Uniform Procedure for the Elaboration of Codex Standards and Related Texts*, Procedural Manual of the Codex Alimentarius Commission).

5. Comments should be submitted through the Codex Contact Points of Codex Members and Observers using the OCS.
