- 3. Consider the approaches presented in Appendices I and III of CX/RVDF 24/27/8 and indicate your support for one of the approaches.
- 4. Should the approach presented by the Electronic Working Group (EWG) in Appendix I of CX/RVDF 24/27/8 be supported, provide general and specific comments on the approach, especially on those sections in square brackets, based on the data/information provided in Appendix II of the said working document.
- 5. Should the approach presented by the EWG in Appendix I be supported, indicate if there is support for the action levels for nicarbazin and lasalocid in chicken eggs as proposed in Appendix II, Part I/Table 7 y and Part II/Table 14, which are reproduced here below for convenience:

Proposed Action Level for Nicarbazin in Chicken Egg

Commodity	Proposed action level (mg/kg)	Notes
Egg	0.220	Marker residue - 4,4'-dinitrocarbanilide (DNC)

Proposed Action Level for Lasalocid in Chicken Egg

Commodity	Proposed action level (mg/kg)	Notes
Egg	0.1	Marker residue – Lasalocid A
