SUBJECT: **Request for Comments at Step 6 on the draft revision to the *Standard for Named Vegetable Oils* (CODEX STAN 210-1999: Addition of Palm Oil with High Oleic Acid (OXG))**

DEADLINE: 30 JUNE 2018

BACKGROUND:

1. The 25th Session of the Committee on Fats and Oils (CCFO25) forwarded the proposed draft revision to the *Standard for Named Vegetable Oils* (CODEX STAN 210-1999: Addition of Palm Oil with High Oleic Acid (OXG)) to CAC40 for adoption at Step 5 (REP17/FO para 43 (ii) and Appendix V)
2. CAC40 adopted the draft revision to the Standard for Named Vegetable Oils (CODEX STAN 210-1999: Addition of Palm Oil with High Oleic Acid (OXG)) at Step 5 and advanced it to Step 6 (REP17/CAC para. 79 and Appendix IV))

REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

3. Codex members and observers are invited to submit comments at Step 6 on the draft revision to the Standard for Named Vegetable Oils (CODEX STAN 210-1999: Addition of Palm Oil with High Oleic Acid (OXG)), which is uploaded to the Codex Online Commenting System (OCS): <https://ocs.codexalimentarius.org/>, as per the general guidance below.

GENERAL GUIDANCE FOR THE PROVISION OF COMMENTS

4. Comments should be submitted through the Codex Contact Points of Codex members and observers using the OCS.
5. Contact Points of Codex members and observers may login to the OCS and access the document open for comments by selecting "Enter" in the "My reviews" page, available after login to the system.
6. Contact Points of Codex members and observers organizations are requested to provide proposed changes and relevant comments/justifications on a specific paragraph (under the categories: editorial, substantive, technical and translation) and/or at the document level (general comments).
7. At the end of the commenting period, the host country secretariat (Malaysia) will compile comments in a relevant working document using the system.
