### **AGENDA ITEM 4 NRVS-R FOR PERSONS AGED 6 – 36 MONTHS**

#### **Comments:**

The Republic of Korea submits following opinions:

- We suggest the definition of 'Adequate intake' should be more precise and clear to avoid ambiguity. The phrase 'approximations or estimates of nutrient intakes' is unclear and seems to require further specification.
- Compared to Approach 2, Approach 1, which reflects data from the past 10 years of RASBs, is considered a more efficient method. However, there are concerns about whether the data is sufficient if Approach 1 is adopted.
- We hold the view that Option 3 appears to be the most appropriate among the three options, as Option 1 and Option 2 present issues of consuming either 'too much' or 'too little' of certain nutrients, while Option 3 poses the least risk of nutrient excess or deficiency.
