The 39th Codex Committee on Food Labelling agreed to allow the inclusion of these substances in Annex 2, Table 2.¹

For spinosad, the Committee agreed that it should be included with the following condition:

"Spinosad should only be used where measures are taken to minimize the risk to parasitoids and to minimize the risk of development of resistance."
