

 The report of the 54th Session of the Codex Committee on Food Additives (CCFA) (<u>REP24/FA</u>) will be considered by the 47th Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (Geneva, Switzerland, 25 - 30 November 2024).

## REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

- Codex Members and Observers are invited to submit comments on the following matters for adoption by the Commission, which have been uploaded to the Codex Online Commenting System (OCS): https://ocs.codexalimentarius.org/, as per the guidance below.
  - 2.1 Proposed draft specifications for the identity and purity of food additives for inclusion in the *List of Codex Specifications for Food Additives* (CXA 6-2023), paragraphs 48, 133 and Appendix III
  - 2.2 Revisions to the General Standard for Food Additives (GSFA, CXS 192-1995), Appendix VI
  - 2.2.1 Draft and proposed draft food-additive provisions of the GSFA and revisions to adopted provisions, paragraph103i and Appendix VI, Part B
  - 2.2.2 Revisions to the descriptors to the Annex B of the GSFA preamble (FC 01.4.3) and Annex C of the GSFA preamble, paragraph 66iii and Appendix. VI, Part A.1.1

3. Comments should address whether the amendments/revision to the above-mentioned texts are ready for adoption or not; and if not, provide the rationale and proposals to facilitate adoption. Comments should be provided in conformity with the *Procedure for the elaboration of Codex standards and related texts* (Part 3 – *Uniform procedure for the elaboration of Codex standards and related texts*), Procedural Manual of the Codex Alimentarius Commission.
