Results from the EFSA/FAO/WHO workshop on the evaluation of the IESTI equation, and preliminary impact analysis

EFSA and the Dutch WHO Collaborating Centre on Chemical Food Safety (RIVM) have organised a Stakeholder Meeting and a Scientific Workshop to seek the views of experts on the IESTI (International Estimate of Short-Term Intake) methodology. Individuals in the field of dietary exposure assessment of pesticide residues representing different geographic and economic regions attended, with the aim of proposing recommendations for harmonising the methodology. FAO and WHO co-sponsored this event, which took place on 7-9 Sept. 2015.

On Monday 25 April during the lunchbreak, 13:15 to 14:15, EFSA and RIVM will present the results of the IESTI event. In addition, preliminary results of an impact analysis on the proposed changes performed by an *ad hoc* working group with members from ANSES (France), APVMA (Australia), BfR (Germany), CRD (UK), EFSA, RIVM (The Netherlands) will be presented.

This side-event will provide further background to new work on revisiting the IESTI that is proposed for discussion by Australia and the EU under agenda item 11, Any other business. (see CRD3)
