General Information

- Currency: Mexican Peso
- Taxi fares within Zihuatanejo US\$2.00 to US\$3.50, within the Ixtapa area US\$3.00 to US\$6.00, between Ixtapa and Zihuatanejo US\$5.00 (From El Palmar area to the Downtown). Other sites from US\$5.00

The rates are fixed and the taxis do not have taximeters. All rates have a surcharge of 50% during the night, from midnight to 6:00am.

- Dialing: Area code is 52 (Mexico) + 755 (Ixtapa-Zihuatanejo) + local number.
- Power: 110 volts.
- According to the law, smoking inside of buildings, hotels, restaurants, shops, etc. is not allowed. Some businesses offer open areas for smokers. If you are a smoker, please ask for the established areas.
- Emergency: Dial 066 (police, fire or rescue services). From a mobile dial 112. If an ambulance is required dial 065 or 114 from a mobile phone.
- The main Credit and Debit Cards, like VISA and MASTERCARD are widely accepted in the most of shops and services in Ixtapa-Zihuatanejo.

AMERICAN EXPRESS, DINERS CLUB, DISCOVER, and other credit cards are also welcome but only in some establishments. Usually they are accepted in Five-star and boutique hotels as well as luxury restaurants.

About Ixtapa-Zihuatanejo - Guerrero, Mexico



Ixtapa-Zihuatanejo is a beautiful tourist destination that is part of the recognized *Triangulo del Sol* of the Mexican state of Guerrero, together with Acapulco, a world icon of Mexico City, and Taxco, a colonial type city destination of the State.

It is located on the shores of the Guerrero State, in the southwest of Mexico, in the area known as the *Pacifico Dorado*, which is part of the famous Mexican Riviera.



During the year, it has a semi-tropical climate with an average of 300 sunny days, and temperatures ranging commonly between 23 and 33 degrees Celsius (73.4 and 91.4 degrees Fahrenheit).

The rainy season is from late June to September and sometimes until mid-October with rainfall, usually in the evenings or nights, which allows to enjoy several hours of sunshine in the day.



The most activities and tours in Ixtapa Zihuatanejo can be done on foot.

Almost everything is close to everything or just a short distance with a relaxing and pleasant walk of 5 to 15 minutes, and when distance is greater and transport is required, the cheapest option are buses (minibuses) and the collective transport ("combis" or "peseras"). There is also a good crew of safe taxis, and their rates are quite reasonable.
