

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 1. The 16<sup>th</sup> Session of the FAO/WHO Coordinating Committee for Africa considered a draft Strategic Plan for the coordination of CCAFRICA as presented by the Delegation of Morocco with the understanding that the adoption of the Strategic Plan would strengthen the role and enhance the participation of CCAFRICA within the Codex Alimentarius Commission and the Region<sup>1</sup>.
- 2. The Committee noted that the draft Strategic Plan required further elaboration and refinement and agreed to append the Strategic Plan to the Report of the 16<sup>th</sup> Session and to request comments by means of a Circular Letter (CL2005/4-AFRICA). The Committee further requested an open-ended Working Group led by Morocco, in cooperation with FAO and WHO, to revise the draft Strategic Plan in light of the comments received in response to the CL and the guidance provided during the 16<sup>th</sup> Session, with the understanding that the revised version of the draft Plan be prepared for approval by the 17<sup>th</sup> Session of the Committee.

#### REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

3. Governments and interested international organizations are invited to comment on the revised draft Strategic Plan for the Coordination of CCAFRICA (see Annex I). The draft Strategic Plan along with the comments submitted will be considered by the 17<sup>th</sup> Session of the FAO/WHO Coordinating Committee for Africa.
