BACKGROUND

1. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the rescheduling of sessions of Codex Committees, the 22nd Session of the Committee on Fresh Fruits and Vegetables (CCFFV22) is scheduled to take place virtually on 25-29 April and 4 May 2022.
2. Following consultations among the Chairperson of CCFFV, the host Secretariat and Codex Secretariat, the need for preparing an advance plan for handling the future work for CCFFV was identified. As a result, it was decided to issue a Circular Letter (CL) requesting proposals for new work.
3. The replies in response to this CL will be compiled in a working document for consideration by CCFFV22.

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION AND COMMENTS

4. Codex Members and Observers are invited to submit proposals for new work through their respective Codex Contact Points before the deadline indicated above.
5. Submissions in response to this CL should include both a discussion paper and proposed project document.
6. CCFFV22 will screen all the new work proposals and related project documents against the criteria for the establishment of work priorities in the Codex Procedural Manual.
