Corrigendum to the working document CX/CF 07/1/6

The paragraph 4 of the working document CX/CF 07/1/6 should be replaced to the following:

4. The document includes: i) the list of maximum levels of contaminants and toxins in foods (Part 1 and Part 2); and ii) Schedule I – Maximum and guideline levels for contaminants and toxins in foods (starting from page 5 and page 54 respectively). In Part 1, issues arising from previous discussions of maximum levels for a contaminant/toxin are surrounded by broken lines while information on the nature and toxicity is surrounded by solid lines. The Schedule presented herewith, which has been prepared on the basis of the one appended to the GSCTF adopted by the 29th Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission, contains the proposed amendments as indicated in CX/CF 07/1/1 Add.1.
