Dr. Christophe Golay is Research Fellow at the Geneva Academy of International Humanitarian Law and Human Rights. His expertise and publications relate to the right to food, peasants' rights, the links between human rights and sustainable development, and the United Nations (UN) human rights bodies.

From 2015 to 2022, Dr. Golay supervised the legal dimension of two research projects on the right to food in Bolivia, Cambodia, Ghana and Kenya. Since 2009, he has been providing legal advice in relation to the elaboration and implementation of the UN Declaration on the Rights of Peasants and Other People Working in Rural Areas (UNDROP). From 2001 to 2008, he was Legal Adviser to the first UN Special Rapporteur on the right to food and undertook missions with the UN in Brazil, Guatemala, Bolivia, Cuba, Niger, Ethiopia, Bangladesh, India and Palestine.
