- Thank you Mr. Chair
- Thailand <u>reiterates</u> its deep <u>concern on the challenges</u> in <u>achieving Zero Hunger by</u>
   2030, with an estimated increase of 783 million people worldwide, still suffering from hunger, as indicated in the 2023 SOFI report.
- We <u>compliment</u> the CFS for its efforts and commitment <u>in achieving its mandate</u> and <u>in developing concise</u>, timely, and <u>action-oriented policy products</u>, as well as for its <u>inclusiveness</u> and engagement to <u>collaborate</u> with all key stakeholders <u>to strengthen implementation on the ground</u> at national and regional levels.
- Bearing in mind that the implementation of the MYPoW will be dependent on the availability of sufficient financial and human resources, and that the workload must be manageable.
