U.S. Comments

- 1) The United States believes that the workload presented is overambitious and does not adequately reduce the intersessional workload, as discussed during the April 17 meeting. As evident during the April 17 OEWG meeting, members have called for a more focused workload for CFS, including prioritizing workstreams and maintaining a realistic approach to the MYPoW.
- 2) Regarding the Data Collection and Analysis Tools event, the United States thinks the stand alone event is a good opportunity to showcase investments and ongoing work from multiple partners in this area and it better fits the intent of the original proposal than the earlier suggestion of mainstreaming data across different policy workstreams.
