- 2. In Brazil, the responsibility for collecting and diffusing data about food and nutritional security at the federal level lies, among others, with the Ministry of Citizenship (formerly Social Development), the Ministry of Health and the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics.
- 3. The federal organs have finished collecting data for the 2022 National Mapping of Food and Nutritional Safety and Mapa Insan, a tool that identifies and locates families in food or nutritional insecurity situation, both which will be published shortly.
