Kuwait comments on CFS first draft in connection with policy recommendations on strengthening data collection and analysis tools of food security and nutrition.

• Definition of food security and nutrition data

Providing any information available on the status of food security and nutrition worldwide, to cover all aspects related to access to food resources, their management, utilization and beneficiaries.

• The actors in the process of data collection

- 1- FAO statistics division plus related regional, sub-regional and country offices.
- 2- FAO member states through the relevant ministries, institutes, relevant authorities and stakeholders of food and nutrition.

• Mechanisms, goals, and assignment of responsibilities.

- 1- All information available are collected and classified by FAO Statistics Division as per each sector to be regularly updated regarding all regions.
- 2- All information available are analyzed by FAO top experts as they make it accessible for policymakers.
- 3- Continuous update of the data to member countries is to be provided by FAO concerned officers in headquarters and regions upon request.
- 4- Member states cooperate with FAO in order to facilitate updates as much as possible and in a transparent manner.

- Feasibility prospects over data collection and analysis of food security and nutrition.
- 1- Allocation for efficient funds and instruments be available for FAO to ensure all official languages for FAO member states as much as possible and wherever it is necessary.
- 2- Use available funds for data collection and analysis on the value of that information as per each sector of interest to food resources and agriculture.
- 3- Conduct special studies on certain data in such a way that helps decision-makers of member countries to take the right steps to face any eventual crisis related to food and agriculture.
- 4- Involve the private sector in partnerships on equal footing (to be specified bilaterally).
- 5- Exchange of data among member countries is to be under FAO umbrella and particularly as regards the dissemination of certain crops that help to resist against climate changes.
- 6- Maintain FAO's responsibilities of providing advice, recommendations and directives to all member countries, whenever necessary, particularly as regards water resources and possible improvements in that sector.
