



Swiss Inputs for OEWG-Meeting on “Data Collection and Analysis Tools for Food Security and Nutrition” – February 6 2023

Switzerland welcomes the draft outline, which already addresses many of the issues the policy recommendations should cover, e.g. coordination and collaboration, harmonization or the implementation. Nevertheless we would like to reiterate the following issues with regard to the development of the first draft of the policy recommendations:

- Food security and nutrition should be addressed in all six dimensions;
- Data to be addressed should follow a food systems approach, including e.g. the drivers of FSN or all dimension of sustainability;
- Cooperation between private and public sectors to standardize datasets and interfaces and make data more usable;
- A human rights based approach should be followed;
- Data governance is a key topic to be addressed in the policy recommendations;
- Personal data need to be protected; and
- Issues related to investments could be addressed in one recommendation.
