Germany comments on the outline of the 2024- 2027 MYPoW

In general, thank you for the updated outline for the MYPoW 2024-2027 (doc. BurAG/2023/04/20/01) and the hard work done, it is very much appreciated.

Moreover, we are happy to support the suggested proposal to cluster "Food security crisis - Conflicts and the fragility of food systems" (original proposals #3 and #12 [by Germany]) as well as to cluster "Addressing emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases affecting food security and nutrition" (original proposals #10 and #14 [by Germany]).

On the suggestion regarding the proposal #36 (In-depth debate on enhanced efforts to increase global awareness and use of CFS Policy Products), we emphasize – as stated before – that this proposal is to be considered as a separate workstream set up as a usual CFS policy convergence process. While now being in the hands of Members, the proposal #36 recommends accordingly to have for example a report at the outset, to nominate a Rapporteur, to set up several OEWG meetings (asking external experts to join), to prepare an outcome document reflecting the inclusive discussions including hands-on recommendations for implementation and uptake. Given the very strong support for proposal #36 expressed by Members and Advisory Group Members for proposal #36 as a stand-alone item at the last CFS Bureau meeting on 20th April, we would like to echo this request here.

Finally, our priorities for the MYPoW 2024-2027, as indicated before, are in general the areas resilience, right to food, biodiversity and climate and the uptake of CFS policy products.
