Egypt's comments on the First Draft of the CFS policy recommendations on Reducing Inequalities for Food Security and Nutrition

Please find below the following comments on the first draft:

- 1- To retain the language used in Para. 3 to the original language used in the Zero Draft.
- 2- In reference to Para. 42: we would like to propose the following language for the para, in lieu of the current one:
- "Address the multiple drivers of food security and nutrition inequalities by working in armed conflict situations with the aim to achieve communities' recovery and resilience".
- 3- To modify the reference to "gender inequalities" to be "**gender inequality**" in all parts of the document.
- 4- To modify the reference to "vulnerable or marginalized groups/people" throughout the document to be **"those who are vulnerable or in vulnerable situations"** instead of using the language "marginalized people/ groups".
