
Global Economic Crisis

Main impacts on food access caused by the global recession

A 5% global economic downturn increases the number of extreme poor by almost 150 million (+20%)




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Panics and hoarding

- So far, 21 countries have responded with export restrictions (11 countries have still active restrictions)
- Affecting about 5% of world food market (share in calories traded), (2% currently)
- G20 ministers and WTO have called for open trade to avoid repeating the problems of 2007-2008—skyrocketing world prices
