## 【 1 】 Location

### 1. Required Time to Nearest DID (Densely Inhabited District)

Draw a circle next to the option best representing the required time to travel from the center of the rural community to the center of the nearest DID (Densely Inhabited District).

Here the "required time" is based on the common mode of transportation used by people in the rural community.

#### Example

When the location serving as the middle of the DID is the city office and the common mode of transportation for people living in the rural community is the automobile, the "required time" is the time it takes to travel from the center of the rural community to the city office by car.
