- 1. In the course of the discussion on this item it is usual practice for the Sub-Group to suspend its formal proceedings and hold informal discussions with representatives of consuming countries. The Sub-Group usually makes recommendations on the levels of indicative prices for African and Brazilian fibre, and for sisal twine. The Sub-Group may wish to review the relevance of recommending indicative prices.
- 2. For the purposes of reporting, the Joint Meeting of the Thirty-fifth Session of the Intergovernmental Group on Hard Fibres and the Thirty-seventh Session of the Intergovernmental Group on Jute, Kenaf and Allied Fibres in 2009 made the following recommendations:
 - The practice of setting indicative prices for sisal should continue as it was a reference point for farmers and was used by governments for policy making decisions;

• The indicative price range for Brazilian No. 3 fibres should be set at USD 700 to USD 800 per tonne, f.o.b. Salvador;

- The indicative price range for East Africa UG fibre should remain at USD 800 to USD 1 000 per tonne, f.o.b.;
- The indicative price for sisal and henequen baler twine should be set as USD 24 to USD 26 per 18 kg bale of regular runnage, f.o.b. Salvador.
