## Discussed were also:

Assuming that the SC would be guided by the proposals, the members are to develop and submit the ideas on joint actions.

As a starting point, to know better capacities of the participating institutions, to identify gaps and strengths within the network, to conduct the survey with the help of the MPS. Identify the lead for this task.

While being generic, try to be specific enough on topics (mountain livelihoods/CC and Adaptation) to cover for the joint projects, capacity building activities, events and communication network.

When went over the 3 paras in the Strategy doc, many questions were raised up re: centers of excellences, who they are and what they qualify for. As such the participants decided not to box them into the limited frame described in the Strategy document under 3. Joint Actions on page 10.

Also suggested was to focus more on the South South exchanges on cross-continental issues, widen the issues across the continents by seeking the experience & expertise in other continents. Under a broad umbrella of the "Mountain Livelihoods" thematic topic, suggested was to begin with the concrete effort on joint marketing in Asia Pacific. This topic is also relevant to Panama and is viewed as good way of bldg people's collective relationship.

Possibilities of joint actions between:

1. ICIPE Kenya/MHub UCA/BIND Philippines, if agree, by Dec 25<sup>th</sup>, questionnaire to be ready

- 2. Grassroots and Central Asia
- 3. BIND and Panama
- 4. BIND and AGOCA

Talked of the importance of the research, specially the applied research, and need in consolidated database in order to understand better the change process and identify the gaps for addressing them effectively. For this purpose, document the CC adaptation practices and solutions such as climate smart agriculture.

Talked of the priorities differing across the regions: In Africa, marketing is not a priority when 60% farmers depend on the food aid. Linking the Food security to the CC and water conservation technologies and know-hows, for instance would be better. To this regard, agro-forestry also needs to be included in order to link science and farming looking into the functional agro-ecosystems.
