Objective of side event:

• Discussion on how to use the synthesis report (and the regional reports on which it is based) for promoting the case of mountains in the post-2015 process (SDGs)

Topics discussed:

- A short introduction was given to the global synthesis report
- A joint offer was then made by ADA, SDC, and UNEP to prepare a series of thematic /sectorial policy briefs for informing the country delegates / members of the Open Working Groups (OWGs) of the Post-2015 Process on the importance of mountains. The themes proposed were chosen in line with the agenda of the upcoming OWG meetings. These will be: energy; DRR and climate change adaptation; biodiversity and forestry. Water security and food security are also planned to be covered owing to the importance of mountains in these two realms.
- In addition to the above sectorial briefs, the offer foresees a brief on mountains as a specific development context
- The discussion showed that the participants supported the preparation of such briefs. The topics suggested were seen as relevant.
- Language will be crucial to win delegates; it was thus proposed to have the briefs available in several languages if time allows.
- The thematic briefs will be prepared by UNEP (MPS through FAO offers support in thematic backstopping and translation), while the brief on mountains as a specific development context will be prepared by MPS / FAO

Follow-up actions planned, if any:

- A first meeting between SDC, UNEP and CDE was scheduled to take place immediately after the side event (time lines, deadlines...)
- CDE will provide UNEP will all requisite background thematic material produced in the course of the Rio+20 process in order to facilitate the preparation of the briefs in time.

 MPS / FAO has shown a strong interest to be involved in the preparation of the policy briefs (discussion of format and contents; translations; production of general brief on mountains).
 CDE is interested in active involvement in discussions on format and contents.
