Project: Ecosystem –based Adaptation in high mountainous regions of Central Asia

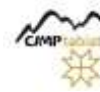
The aim: To increase the resilience of people reliant upon services provided by nature, by addressing the degradation of ecosystems and thereby reducing their vulnerability to climate change.

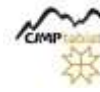
Objectives of the project:

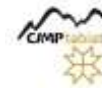

- The pilot projects serve as a showcase, in order to support the policies and strategies in the region with experience based adaptation as well as the programmes of international development partners and finance institution, such as the World Bank.

Planned measures

- Climate informed management of concept ecosystem
- Using the example of two small watersheds
- Developing measures in collaboration with the local communities and project partners
- Focus on capacity building.
- Integrating the concept in the policy dialogue at national, regional and international level.
