#### **ABSTRACT**

As a strategy to develop mountain economies and better livelihoods, the Mountain Partnership Secretariat and Slow Food jointly developed a voluntary labelling scheme for mountain products to support small mountain producers from developing countries. The scheme includes value chain improvement, marketing strategy development and the granting of the Mountain Partnership Product label. The side event will present the main achievements of the first phase of the Mountain Partnership Products (MPP) Initiative and will offer the opportunity to discuss on sustainable food systems, market linkages and the role of partnerships, with representatives from the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Swiss Permanent Mission to FAO, Slow Food and FAO representatives. Practical experiences from two pilot cases of the MPP Initiative will be shared.
