Mountains are a rich source of renewable energy.

Some countries such as Bhutan are exporting hydropower as a commodity. Rwanda has set a goal of generating 1,000 megawatts of power for domestic use and export by 2017. This largely untapped energy potential means that mountains have the power to help shift world consumption away from the fossil fuels that are a major cause of global warming. Rising urbanization and the expansion of mega-cities increase demand in lowland regions, which look to mountains to supply much of their energy.
