We emphasise that these innovations should be accessible to all communities and Indigenous Peoples to facilitate information sharing.<li data-bbox="572 1225 1934 1351">• We note with interest the Council's request that FAO consider an initiative to mainstream biodiversity in food systems in consultation with Members. We would like to encourage the FAO and Members to also consider the opportunities to use the biodiversity of trees and forests in the supplements, pharmaceutical, cosmetics and nutraceutical areas, which can complement and diversify existing sustainable forest practices.
