# Regional Soil Laboratory Network (RESOLAN) main needs - survey 2021

Countries are organized into Regional Soil Laboratory Networks (RESOLANs), the skeleton of GLOSOLAN. After the successful establishment of the Regional Soil Laboratory Networks for Asia (SEALNET) in 2017, Latin America (LATSOLAN) in 2018, and the Pacific (ASPAC), Africa (AFRILAB), Europe and Eurasia (EUROSOLAN) in 2019, GLOSOLAN successful launched the Regional Soil Laboratory Network for the Near East and North Africa (NENALAB) on 9 June 2020. Each RESOLAN has a Chair and one or two vice-Chairs that represent the regional networks at official events.

Every year, laboratories from a same region are given the opportunity to discuss about their priorities and needs, and their position on topics to be discussed at the annual GLOSOLAN meetings. Usually, RESOLAN meetings consist of three-four days training and one day for decision making. However, in 2020, GLOSOLAN made the decision to change the format of the meetings. Therefore, RESOLAN meetings will now consist of only one day focused on decision making since trainings will be provided in the form of webinars throughout the year

In order to facilitate the discussion and optimize the use of the limited time available for discussion, GLOSOLAN is kindly asking all its members to complete the following survey. The survey enquired on national and regional specific needs to be brought to the attention of each RESOLAN for discussion. Ultimately, RESOLAN specific work plans will be developed.






Are you in touch with the Chair and/or vice Chair(s) of your Regional Soil Laboratory Network?







# Participation in Proficiency Tests (PT)









### LATSOLAN main needs

analysis






### Training topics – most needed ones






# Awareness and support from the national and regional governments your government providing your laboratory
