




# Source of funds in terms of FAO internal accounting system\*



\*all reported by 2023; the split was not done before 2015




#### Source of funds in terms of Donors since 2012

### The GSP - The way forward!

A number of new grants have been provided in 2023-2024 and some are currently still under negotiation, which are detailed below:

- The USA An additional <u>USD 10 million</u> on top of the USD 20 million, bringing the project to <u>USD 30 million in total</u> (already initiated in May 2023)
- PhosAgro An additional <u>USD 3 million</u> to the USD 2.4 million making the project of <u>USD 5.4 million overall</u> (already initiated in 2018)
- Germany **USD 1.6 million** (Phase II of Soil4Nutrition project)
- Ongoing discussions with Japan, the People's Republic of China, and the Russian Federation
